

Expression of Interest Production Trainees – Mining Dept. (24-month Traineeship)

Batchfire is offering Production Trainee opportunities for recent Callide Valley School leavers with a genuine interest in developing a career in mining.

Trainees will complete a structured training plan to achieve a Certificate III in Surface Extraction Operations, plus obtaining coal competencies in operating various types of heavy mining equipment.

This opportunity is offered strictly in accordance with the following terms:

- Trainees are to be residents of the Callide Valley Regional Area (includes townships of Biloela, Goovigen, Jambin, Thangool and their immediate areas),
- Applicants must be at least 17 years of age and possess a valid driver's licence,
- Trainees will have completed schooling within the last 3 years,
- The length of the traineeship will be 24 months maximum. Employment terminates at the end of 24 months and trainees will NOT automatically be considered for immediate permanent placement,
- Employment engagement benefits as detailed in the Callide Enterprise Agreement 2017 or current Enterprise Agreement.

Employment start date is planned for Monday April 21st, 2020.

- Commitment to high health, safety and environmental standards,
- Genuine interest in operating plant and heavy machinery,
- Willingness to work shift work, and
- Ability to work as part of a team.
